This letter responds to your request for advice on behalf of the Burbank-Glendale-Pasadena Airport Authority regarding Government Code Section 1090, et seq.¹ We have reviewed your request for advice, and we decline to provide formal advice because the request presents an overly broad, or hypothetical question that lacks a specific issue or accompanying facts necessary to evaluate and analyze the required elements of compliance. (Regulation 18329(b)(6)(F).) As we discussed by phone, you may request advice once you can present more specific facts regarding the contract and parties at issue.
